A power of attorney is a legal document that allows you to appoint another person to make health, property, financial, and other legal decisions on your behalf. This is relevant to your health care because the person you appoint to manage your finances may have an important role in determining the health care you receive.

SWITCHING YOUR COVERAGE

Already in a Medicare Advantage Plan, but looking to switch?

- Original Medicare contact 1-800-MEDICARE or get in touch with your current plan
- Want a different MA plan? During AEP, select your new plan. You will then be disenrolled automatically from your previous plan when your new coverage begins.

Do you have other coverage?

- Make sure you talk to who you currently have coverage through (union, employer, or other benefits administrator). In some cases, when you join an MA plan, it could cause you to lose the coverage you currently have.
